OVERVIEW/DESCRIPTION OF CURRICULUM

HealthTeacher.com is a comprehensive health education curriculum for the elementary, middle, and high school levels. HealthTeacher provides online curriculum resources to teachers with access to over 334 lessons plans, activities, and resources. Lessons have been developed for grade groupings K-1, 2-3, 4-5, MS, and HS. Lessons can be taught as stand-alone lessons or used to support an existing curriculum. HealthTeacher has lessons addressing key health topics including alcohol and other drugs, community and environmental health, family health and sexuality, injury prevention, personal and consumer health, tobacco prevention, nutrition, physical activity, and mental health. Lessons are aligned with Colorado Comprehensive Health Education standards as well as Common Core, National and Gifted and Talented standards. Background information is provided, along with resources for teaching key health skills, literacy connections, online test creation and administration, and interactive presentations. New lessons are added monthly.

Lessons are grade grouped if HealthTeacher is used across multiple grade levels it will be important to identify the lessons that will be taught at each specific grade level. Many of the lessons are aligned with the health education standards at multiple grade levels. For example, one lesson may address standards at grade 4 and grade 5. It will be important to identify the scope and sequence of lessons for each grade level if the curriculum is going to be used across grade levels. HealthTeacher does not have empirical research that has shown its effectiveness in changing health behaviors. The curriculum does address the Colorado Comprehensive Health Education Standards with minor adaptations.
