

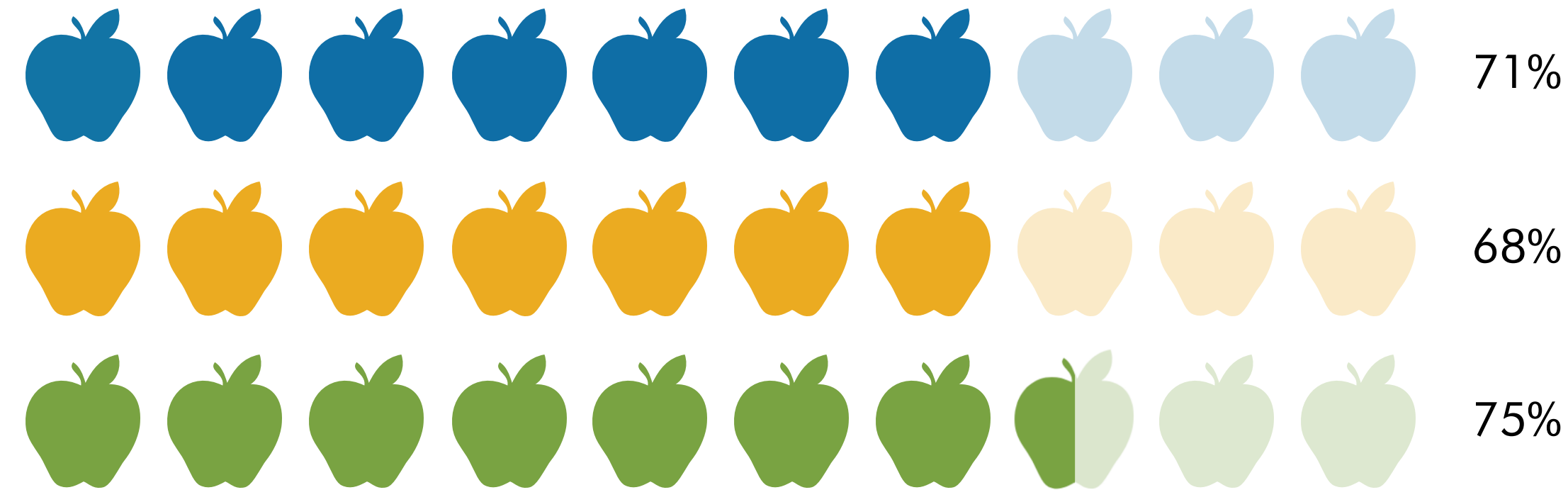

SCHOOLS WITH WELLNESS TEAM

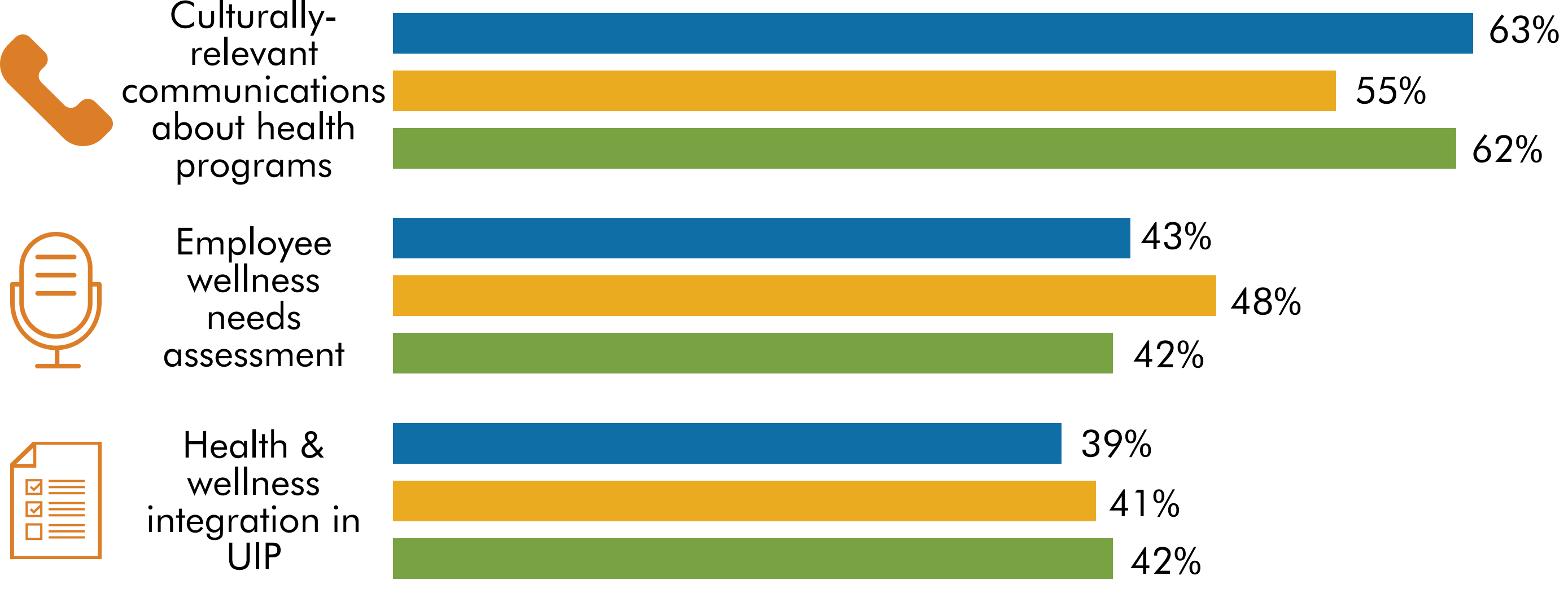


Other examples of a Wellness Team may include a School Health Council, a School Health Committee, or other organized group that offers guidance on the development of health policies or coordination of health activities.

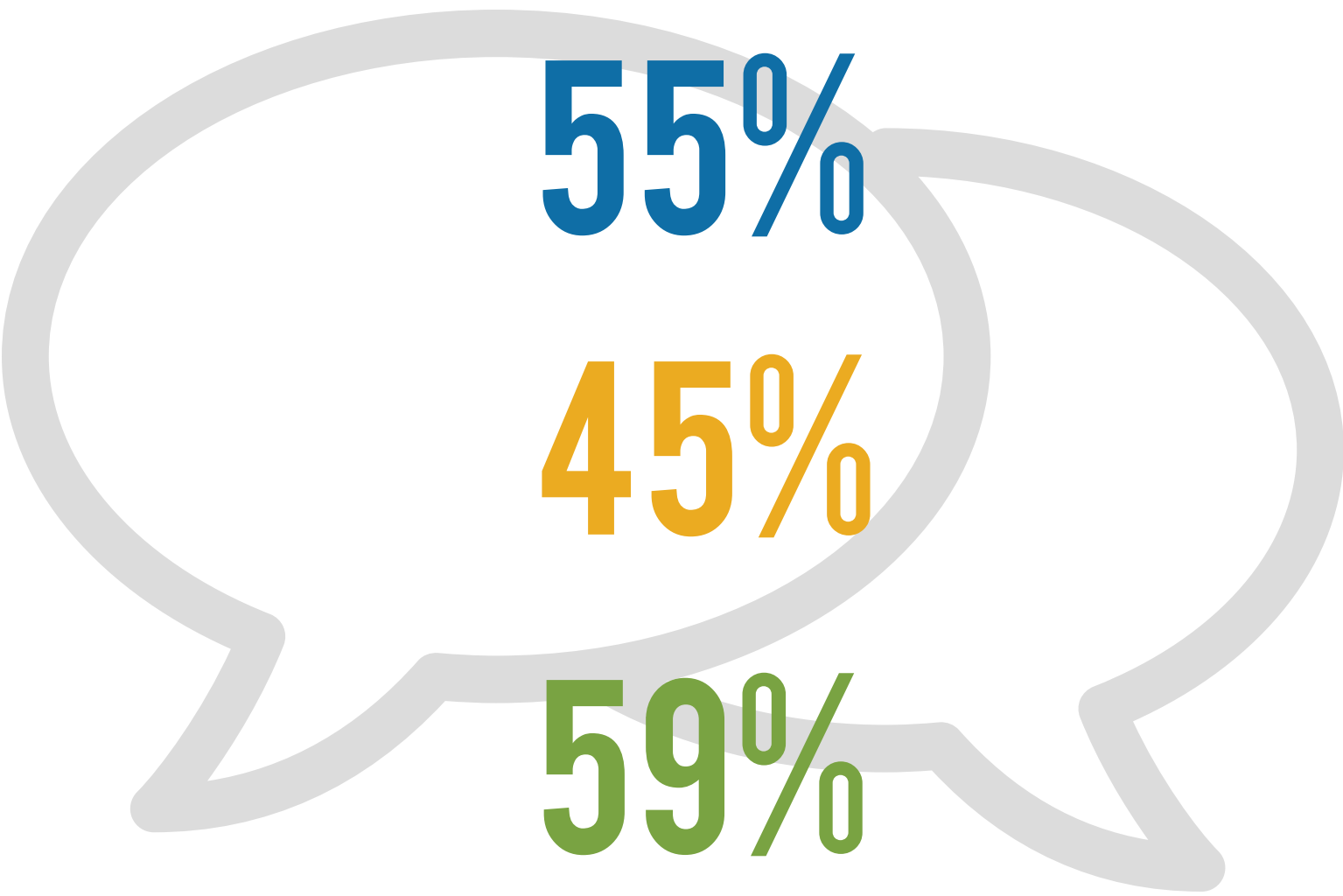
SCHOOLS TRAINING MOST STAFF IN RESPONSIVE PRACTICES



SCHOOLS PRIORITIZING INTEGRATION OF SCHOOL HEALTH

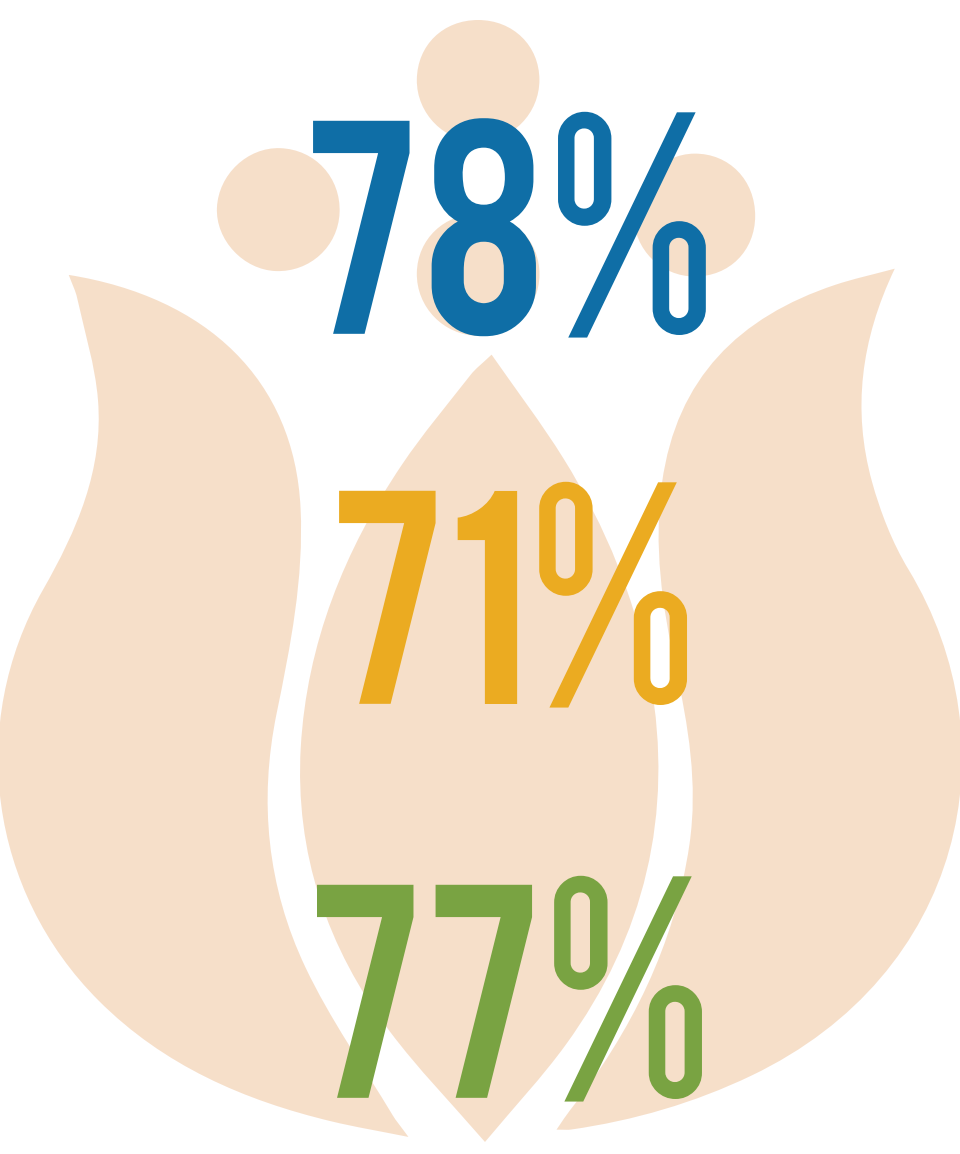


SCHOOLS GATHERING INPUT FROM FAMILIES ON SCHOOL HEALTH ACTIVITIES
