The ideal candidate will have experience working in and with schools and/or school districts, as well as a high interest in and experience with navigating relationships with multiple stakeholders with complex and sometimes competing visions. This person is skilled at building relationships with school and district leaders, policymakers, and partner organizations, and is committed to equitable approaches and outcomes in education. The role requires daily management of projects and details, while considering a vision for future long-term success. The ideal candidate demonstrates high aptitude for inquiry and empathy, comfort in ambiguity, strong writing skills, and proficient project management and communication skills.

The candidate is excited to join a team grounded in the CEI mindsets: dream big, act small, and pivot quickly; constant learning and adaptation; flexible, nimble, and purposeful; and partnership and service orientation. In addition to the qualifications described throughout this description, the candidate will exhibit belief in and comfort with the CEI Design Commitments, including change management; diversity, equity, and inclusion; youth activation; family and community partnership; social emotional development; and leadership. This position will report to the Vice President of Policy and Partnership.

- Collaborate with internal CEI teams, including Data and Field Implementation, to ensure effective policy implementation.
- Continuously evaluate and refine policy strategies based on outcomes and feedback.

- Collaborate closely with team members to align policy efforts with CEI's strategic priorities.
- Foster a positive and collaborative team environment.

Qualifications

A successful candidate will have a bachelor's degree in education, public policy, or a related field, and a minimum of three years of experience in education policy analysis, advocacy, or related roles. They will bring significant understanding of education policy issues, legislation, and emerging trends, or demonstrate aptitude navigating a landscape to quickly build significant understanding. They will bring comprehensive research, analytical, and data interpretation skills, alongside excellent written and verbal communication skills. The candidate will have a demonstrated ability to build and maintain relationships with diverse stakeholders across organizations, and a record of working with humility and persistence to serve partners and teams to which they are accountable. They will be organized, detail-oriented, and able to manage multiple projects simultaneously.

This role requires occasional travel, up to 10 percent of working days.

Competencies

This position requires strong collaboration, relationship building, and multi-tasking skills, and the ability to anticipate and take initiative to predict and solve problems. The candidate will also demonstrate strong emotional intelligence, curiosity, and a willingness to collaborate with internal CEI staff and external partners.
